


Network of Care CAB Update



ACCESS

- •Total referrals via One Degree from NoC clinics
- •Number of closed loop referrals (CLR) via One Degree from NoC clinics
- •Type of referrals/ reason for referral through One Degree

ALIGNMENT AND QUALITY

- Number of CBOs in the Network of Care
- •Percentage of NoC clinical team members and NoC partner CBOs reporting ease of sharing information across systems by virtue of participation in ACEs-LA (Provider reported via survey, Likert scale)
