

Frank D. Lanterman - Tip Sheet

WHO CAN REFER A PATIENT/CLIENT?

Anyone can submit a referral with approval of the patient/family.

HOW DO YOU REFER PATIENTS < 3 YEARS OLD?

Best way: E-mail referrals@lanterman.org and provide the following info:

- your name,
- your telephone number,
- your address,
- · your child's name and birth date,
- and a short explanation as to your concerns.

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER REFERRAL?

An intake coordinator will call you back within 24 hours to gather further information, and if appropriate, will initiate the necessary assessments required to determine eligibility for Early Start services. Eligibility is determined within 45 days from the initial contact.

WHAT PATIENTS CAN BE SEEN BY SCLARC IF THEY ARE > 3 YEARS OLD?

Those patients covered under the Lanterman Act with substantial disability due to:

- Intellectual Disability (IQ < 70)
- Epilepsy
- Cerebral Palsy
- Autism
- Other closely related conditions

HOW DO YOU REFER PATIENTS > 3 YEARS OLD?

Best way: E-mail <u>referrals@lanterman.org</u> provide the following info:

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER REFERRAL?

An intake specialist will call you back within 24 hours to gather information from you, and if the referral is appropriate, will schedule an appointment to learn more about your family, developmental history and special needs. If needed, the intake specialist may schedule other assessments to assist with eligibility determination. Eligibility is determined within 120 days from the initial contact
