# WHAT HAPPENS AFTER REFERRAL?

For children birth to 3 years of age, it can take up to 45 days to determine eligibility.

WHAT PATIENTS CAN BE SEEN BY WESTSIDE RC IF THEY ARE > 3 YEARS OLD?

<sup>\*</sup>Anyone can make a referral, including parents, legal guardians or conservators, medical care providers, neighbors, family members, foster parents, and daycare providers. Professionals and concerned persons may make a referral, however, the permission of the parent or legal guardian is necessary. Legally ordered evaluations may come from the courts or the Department of Children and Family Services (DCFS).

<sup>\*</sup>Sending copies of completed ASQ's, MCHATS, and other developmental screeners is extremely helpful to the Westside team!

Those patients covered under the Lanterman Act with substantial disability due to:

- Intellectual Disability (IQ < 70)
- Epilepsy
- Cerebral Palsy
- Autism
- Other closely related conditions

## WHAT HAPPENS AFTER REFERRAL?

For children over 3 and adults, it can take up to 120 days.

An eligibility team will review your records and assessments. Once a decision is made, an intake coordinator will contact you to inform you of your child's eligibility status and team recommendations. If not eligible, the intake team will make recommendations and try to provide you with appropriate resources in the community. If you disagree with the eligibility decision, you always have the right to appeal the decision.
