

### Provider Network



### **Specialty Mental Health Services LACDMH**

- Higher level of care
- Experiencing moderate to severe symptoms / significant impairments in functioning
- Youth who are involved in the child welfare system, current or hx in juvenile hall / probation, homeless
- Need for more intensive services such as
  - TCM to facilitate linkage to ancillary services/resources
  - Intensive Care Coordination for youth involved in 2 or more child serving systems (e.g., DMH, Regional Center)
- Need for more intensive 24/7 programs such as
  - Full Service Partnership (FSP)
  - Wraparound

## Non-Specialty Mental Health Services Managed Care Plan

- Lower level of care
- Experiencing mild to moderate symptoms / impairments
- Need for mental health services, including:
  - Psychotherapy (individual, family and group)
  - Psychological / neuropsychological testing
  - Medication (prescribing, monitoring, ordering/reviewing labs)

- Agent will
  - Obtain some basic info (e.g., reason for referral, contact info of the potential client)
  - Identify a provider who would be a good fit (using our online Provider Directory)
  - Send the request electronically to that provider
  - The provider will attempt to contact the potential client/caregiver as soon as possible to schedule an appointment

#### MCP – Non-SMHS
