- CAB Membership: 22+ members comprised of clinicians and CBO leaders
- Community Voice: The CAB's commitment to providing ideas and solutions makes the Network of Care stronger. At DHS, the CAB represents the communities we serve. Your voices are vital to continue improvements and enhancements to patient care. Our monthly meetings provide a space for DHS clinicians and CAB members to engage in conversation.
- One Degree CLR Launch and Implementation: We launched the CLR feature in One
 Degree in April 2022 that allow bi-directional communication between DHS clinics and
 CBOs in the Network of Care.
- **Capstone Project:** The CAB's impact became measurable through this effort and brought about honest conversations on barriers to success of DHS-CBO engagement and the One Degree CLR implementation.
- One Degree Dashboard: We have started monitoring referrals from DHS clinics to CBOs and will be sharing this dashboard for your feedback in early 2023.
- **CAB Feedback Loop:** The CAB enriches our training and outreach efforts both to DHS clinics and CBOs, notably on CLR referral status and One Degree guidelines.
