Are you ACEs Aware?

ACEs (Adverse Childhood Experiences) are traumatic events that happen during childhood and adolescence that contribute to poor health and quality of life. It will come as no surprise that children and families served in DHS clinics and acute care settings experience more ACEs than the general population. The California ACEs Aware initiative – launched in 2020 through the California Office of the Surgeon General – aims to promote screening for, treatment for, and healing from ACEs through a statewide campaign. This process starts with the core training: *Becoming ACEs Aware*. The ACEs-LA NoC team would like to invite all our partners and their teams to take the training over the next four weeks. This is a great opportunity to gain an understanding of ACEs and support our partners in health as we work together to address toxic stress.

The training is free and takes about two hours to complete.

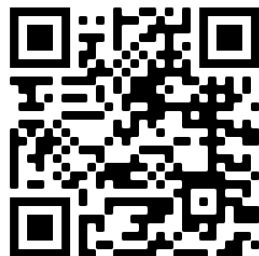

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One Degree Tip Sheet

Status Options in One Degree Closed-Loop referrals.

Status option	Dropdown or Automatic	When to use
Acknowledged	Automatic <i>Status changes to acknowledged once acknowledged button is clicked</i>	Referral has been acknowledged. ACEs-LA recommends responding within one business day or receipt.
Assigned	Automatic <i>Status changes to Assigned once the CBO admin assigns the referral to a staff member</i>	Referral has been assigned to a provider.
In Progress	Dropdown	CBO in process of establishing contact with client, reviewing eligibility and capacity. ACE's-LA encourages continued communication with DHS referrer if possible.
Not Eligible	Dropdown	CBO determines client does not fit eligibility criteria
Not Utilized	Dropdown	CBO is unable to reach client after multiple attempts.
Utilized	Dropdown	Client is able to receive services from CBO.

*REMINDER: Please do not use One Degree to transmit Protected Health Information (PHI)
