One Degree Tip Sheet

Status Options

Status option	Dropdown or Automatic	When to use
Acknowledged	Automatic <i>Status changes to acknowledged once acknowledged button is clicked</i>	Referral has been acknowledged. ACEs-LA recommends responding within one business day or receipt.
Assigned	Automatic <i>Status changes to Assigned once the CBO admin assigns the referral to a staff member</i>	Referral has been assigned to a provider.
In Progress	Dropdown	CBO in process of establishing contact with client, reviewing eligibility and capacity. ACE’s-LA encourages continued communication with DHS referrer if possible.
Not Eligible	Dropdown	CBO determines client does not fit eligibility criteria
Not Utilized	Dropdown	CBO is unable to reach client after multiple attempts or Client refuses services.
Utilized	Dropdown	Client can receive services from CBO.
