

#### <u>Our Programs</u>

Each family's situation is different and the services we offer will depend on their situation.

- Problem Solving
- Homelessness Prevention
- Time Limited Subsidy
- Housing Navigation
- Crisis Housing/Interim Housing (shelter)
- Referrals to other resources that may help stabilize the family's situation

• Who we serve: Families experiencing homelessness: defined by

HUD

- Literal Homelessness/ Catatory 1
  - Sleeping somewhere not meant for human habitation (outdoors, vehicle, park or tent. etc)
  - emergency shelters , transitional programs, motels (paid by nonprofit or DPSS)
  - Families at risk of losing their current housing, due to 3, 10 day notice or an unlawful detainer
- Families Fleeing Domestic Violence

- Who we serve: continued -Eligibility
  - Households with at least 1+ minor child in custody of the person seeking assistance (biological –proof of birth or non-biological w/proof of custody.
  - Head of household is pregnant at any trimester (proof of pregnancy needed)
  - Household with young adult over age 18- must provide support of full dependency of person seeking services, or 18 year old, still in high school.
