Friends L.A. is part of a national network with 30 years of experience in creating generational change by empowering youth who are facing the greatest obstacles through relationships with professional mentors – 12+ years, no matter what.





Our successful model is in 36 locations.

Our Model

FRIENDS: We employ full-time salaried, professional mentors called Friends. Moving mentorship out of the volunteer realm is a key component to getting the quality, consistency and commitment children need.

COMMIT FOR THE LONG HAUL:

12+ years. No matter what.

INDIVIDUALIZED AND INTENTIONAL: We focus on the growth potential of each child. Each Friend spends a **minimum of 16 intentional hours per month**.

HOME, SCHOOL, COMMUNITY

Friends spend **two (2) hours 1:1** in each child's home, neighborhood, and community. Friends spend **two (2) hours** a week in the child's **classroom**

92% of youth go on to enroll in postsecondary education, serve our country or enter the workforce.



83% of youth earn a high school diploma or GED.



93% of youth remain free from juvenile justice system involvement.



98% of youth wait to parent until after their teen years.

2 Generation Approach (2Gen)

Our child-centered, 2Gen approach strengthens key protective factors for overall child well-being:

- Concrete Supports
- Social Connections
- Parental Resilience
- Knowledge of Parenting & Child Development
- Social & Emotional Competence of Children
