FREE SUMMER LUNCH & SNACK PROGRAM

LACO Parks and Recreation implements a FREE Summer, Lunch, and Snack program at 49 sites across LA County. We're able to serve an estimated 77,000 snacks and lunches over the summer.

- Children and youth ages 0-18 are eligible to receive lunch and snack.
- 20 LA County Libraries also serve snack and lunch over the summer.
- Summer Program operates: June 16th through August 8th
 - (No Lunch and snack on June 19 and July 4)
- County Parks and County Libraries will serve lunch from 12:00PM to 1:00PM.
- County Parks will serve snacks from 3:00PM to 4:00PM.



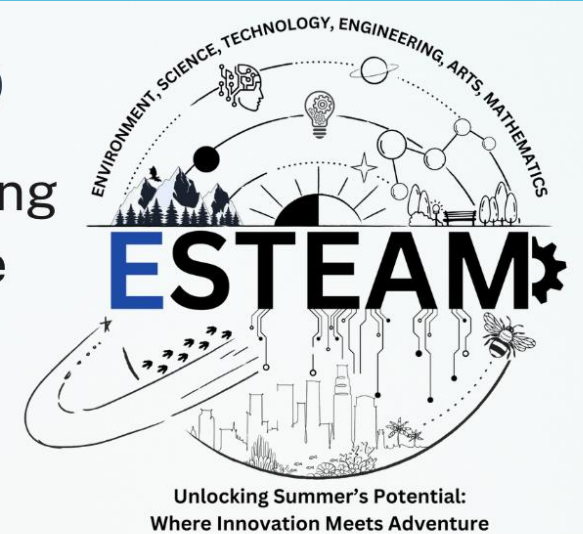
2025 ESTEAM SUMMER CAMP
