Free Summer Lunch, and Snack Program

- LACO Parks and Recreation implements a FREE Summer, Lunch, and Snack program at 47 sites across LA County. We're able to serve an estimated 77,000 snacks and lunches over the summer

- Children and youth ages 0-18 are eligible to receive lunch and snack. 15 LA County Libraries also serve snack and lunch over the summer (more library locations to come).

- Summer Program operates June 10th through August 2nd (No Lunch and snack on June 19 and July 4)

- County Parks and County Libraries will serve lunch from 12 to 1PM.

- County Parks will serve snacks from 3 to 4 p.m.



What We Offer

- Food items include vegetables, fruits, seeds and healthy dairy products like milk, string cheese and yogurt. Lunches will include sandwiches, wraps, salads, etc.
- Youth meals will be available for dine in only at enclosed designated areas. Lunch and snack will be provided to youth participants only.
