- **Update** emergency contacts

- **Share** copies of medical information



- **Ensure** your child has a passport

- **Signing** contracts

3 KNOW YOUR RIGHTS



IF ICE IS AT THE DOOR



- **DO NOT** open the door

Unless ICE has a judge-signed warrant with your correct address and name on it

- **DO NOT** answer questions or share personal information

- **DO NOT** sign anything

- **Memorize** important contacts
You have the right to make phone calls

- Use a **Know Your Rights Red Card**

- **Remain Calm**

Safety & Safe Passage


- Coordinated partnerships with municipal leaders for protective measures in surrounding communities

> USE THE LASAR APP OR CALL LASPD COMMUNICATIONS AT (213) 625-6631 TO ALERT SCHOOLS OF IMMIGRATION ENFORCEMENT ACTION.

The Los Angeles Schools Anonymous Reporting (LASAR) app allows the school community to anonymously report non-emergency events—such as Immigration and Customs Enforcement activity near an LAUSD school—and share the location for an appropriate response. Families and community members can also contact LASPD Communications at (213) 625-6631.
