## WHAT IT IS:

The Domestic Abuse Response Team (DART) is a specialized program at Casa de la Familia, developed to provide immediate, compassionate support for survivors of domestic abuse. DART works closely with six Los Angeles Police Department stations to offer survivors a safe pathway to resources and healing.

# IMMIGRATION EVALUATIONS

Casa de la Familia continues to work with victims of trauma, many of whom qualify for [U-Visa](#) or [T-Visa](#), or [VAWA](#). We also perform hardship waivers and evaluations to avoid deportation.

We understand the hardships our clients face in trying to create a new life in the United States, the hardships they may be confronted with if forced to return to their country of origin, and the impact on their loved ones, specifically children, that are left in the US without their parent(s).


