Every Body Plays After-School Program is a free drop-in program serving children ages 7 to 17. Supervised by trained Recreation staff, every day is an adventure in parks where children can choose from a variety of activities, from homework help, group games, sports and fitness, hands-on ESTEAM projects, cultural experiences, events, field trips, and enrichment classes. Children will build confidence, be a part of a team, learn pro-social skills, and most of all, have FUN.

The Youth@Work Program provides paid work experience opportunities for youth and young adults across LA County parks. Through hands-on employment, participants gain valuable job skills, career exposure, and professional development in a supportive and structured environment.

- Seasonal employment opportunities
- Available at LA County park locations
- Youth and young adults (ages 14 - 24)
- Includes job readiness and workplace training
- Supervised by DPR staff and program partners

- Paid work experience
- Career exploration and skill development
- Resume building and interview preparation
- Mentorship and professional guidance
- Supports youth workforce development initiatives

The program connects children to the outdoors while building confidence, exploring early career pathways, and strengthening ESTEAM skills. Campers will participate in group games, arts and cultural activities, guest speakers, outdoor field trips, and hands-on technology experiences in **robotics, coding, gaming, and engineering.**

ESTEAM SUMMER CAMP

ESTEAM Summer Camp is a free, hands-on enrichment program offered by LA County Parks that engages youth in hands-on learning across Environment, Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math (ESTEAM). Through project-based learning, outdoor exploration, and creative activities, participants build critical thinking skills, confidence, and interest in STEAM-related pathways across 22 LA County park locations.
