- Core or modified core curriculum programs for eligible students with disabilities who are at highest risk of losing critical skills (regression) during school breaks and take an unreasonable amount of time to regain them (recoupment).
 - Students on core curriculum in grades TK-7 will use the same instructional program as students in DOI summer term and students in grades 8-12 will use other materials to support core instruction.
 - Students on modified core/alternate curriculum will use Unique Learning Systems (ULS) to continue learning from the regular year

Note: Students with disabilities are also welcome to participate in any summer programs through the school district.
